Dear valued supplier,

It is an unfortunate fact of the modern world that theft of information from computers and information systems occurs on a regular basis. From time to time we are made aware of cyber-theft incidents that have caused inadvertent disclosures of commercial and technical information that is proprietary and should have been kept confidential.

We believe the cybersecurity of your computer and information systems is essential for you. However, as you are provided confidential information that originates from Fokker Aerostructures B.V. and/or its customers, also other parties have an interest that your computers and information systems are protected adequately. As Fokker Aerostructures B.V. is involved in several programs of the United States Government, also these US government authorities have an interest in the prevention of cyber-theft incidents.


To secure the interest of the US Department of Defense, it has adopted Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement 252.204-7012 regarding Cybersecurity. If you are supplier under a contract of Fokker Aerostructures B.V. and if you have received Covered Defense Information, your computers and information systems shall comply at the latest on December 31, 2017 with the information security requirements as set forth in NIST SP 800-171 (National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Special Publication (SP) 800-171, "Protecting Controlled Unclassified Information in Nonfederal Information Systems and Organizations," <http://nvlpubs.nist.gov/nistpubs/SpecialPublications/NIST.SP.800-171r1.pdf>.)

To the extent you share Covered Defense Information with sub-tiers, you shall inform them to comply with the NIST SP 800-171 requirements latest on December 31, 2017 also.

It is imperative that our suppliers who receive Covered Defense Information understand what's at stake and recognize our shared role in protecting Covered Defense Information, including but not limited to all export controlled information and IP that you have received through Fokker Aerostructures B.V..

We appreciate your understanding and seek your full collaboration to adopt and implement the measures as described in NIST SP 800-171 to prevent cyber-theft incidents.
